Best Ph.D. thesis in combustion and related fields in memory of Prof. Antonio D'Alessio

The Italian Section of the Combustion Institute (ASICI) is pleased to announce the 2nd edition of the Antonio D'Alessio Award to acknowledge a remarkable Ph.D. thesis in combustion and related fields. The prize commemorates Antonio D'Alessio's career, scientific achievements, and contributions to the Italian Section community. The award recognizes exceptional thesis work, encompassing either combustion fundamentals or applications, particularly within the context of energy transition and sustainable processes, by addressing relevant chemical, physical, and environmental aspects. It aims to highlight contributions that advance our understanding and address critical issues in these domains. The prize will be awarded at the 47th Meeting of the Italian Section of the Combustion Institute. The winner will be invited to deliver a brief overview of their thesis work during the event. This occasion provides an opportunity to showcase the recipient's research accomplishments and further contribute to the



intellectual exchange within the combustion research community. The prize contains an Award document, a sum of 1.000 Euros, plus complimentary registration to the 47th meeting of the Italian Section. The evaluation committee will be announced following the submission deadline.

Instructions

- Eligibility: Every candidate who was awarded her/his Ph.D. by an Italian Institution from January 1st, 2023 to December 31st, 2024. Eligible candidates can be nominated by their thesis tutor or other suitable member of the Italian section.
- Nomination Package must include:
- 1. Letter of support from the thesis supervisor;
- 2. Short CV (Max. 1 page);
- 3. Copy of the Ph.D. thesis;
- 4. Brief description (Max. 3 pages) of the objectives and the results of the research;
- 5. List of publications and conference presentations.
- Deadline for Nominations: 26 March 2025.
